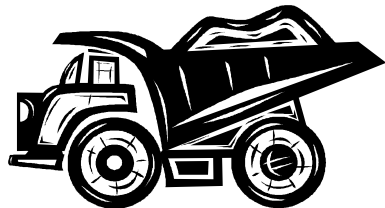

Building Permit applications may be picked up daily at the Code Enforcement office.

Building permit applications MUST be submitted prior to the commencement of work. Upon issuance of permit, the applicant must contact the Code Enforcement Officer upon completion of each stage of work and for final inspection.

A permit is valid for twelve months and must be renewed if work is not completed within this time.

Before burning, a burn permit must be applied for and granted by the Code Enforcement Officer. Applications are available at the Codes Office.

The Assessor maintains the municipality’s assessment roll, which contains a physical description and value calculation of every parcel. The value is utilized as a component in tax bill calculations along with local, county, state and school district tax rates. The property inventory is available for inspection.

The Assessor also approves and keeps track of property tax exemptions. Among the most common exemptions are:

- Senior Citizen exemption
- School Tax Relief (STAR)
- Veteran’s exemption
- Agricultural exemption
- Business exemption

Important Dates

March 1st – Deadline for filing exemptions

May 1st – Tentative Roll filed

July 1st – Final Assessment Roll filed

- **SENIOR STAR** must re-apply and prove income each year

Passports: You can apply for a Passport in the Clerk's office Monday - Friday from 9:00 AM to 3:30 PM or pick up a Renewal By Mail application for a Passport. Please call for more information.

Marriage Licenses: Must be purchased at least 24 hours before ceremony and can be purchased up to 60 days in advance. Fee is \$40.00. Call the office for an appointment.

Sporting Licenses: All DEC approved hunting, fishing and small game licenses can be purchased at the Clerk's office. Lifetime licenses are also available. Call for fees.

Handicap Parking Permits: Issued to Van Buren residents only. Must have application completed by a physician and a NYS Driver's license.

GENERAL INFORMATION

All residents must contract with a private hauler for their trash pick up.

“Blue Bins” for recycling are available in the Clerk's office, as are battery bags.

All yard waste must be transported to an OCRRA facility. The closest one is on Airport Rd in Amboy. Their hours are Mon., Thurs, & Fri. 1 – 4 P.M. Tues 9-4 P.M. and Sat. 9 A.M. – 4 P.M. Closed on Wednesdays. Purchase of a \$10.00 pass is required at the beginning of the season. Mulch is available for free with your fee.

Notary Service is available free of charge at the Town Hall.

The Town of Van Buren is protected by four volunteer Fire Depts. : Baldwinsville, Lakeside, Memphis and Warners.

All town residents are protected by the Onondaga County Sheriff's Dept.

The Town of Van Buren was inhabited by fierce Iroquois Indians at the time of the European discovery.

After the Revolutionary War, land was given to soldiers in lieu of money. In February 1789, the Land Office Commissioners directed that a survey of the military tract be completed and the land given to the soldiers. Only one soldier settled his lot in Van Buren, John Cunningham. The area was still a wilderness so most men sold their lots, this created a period of land speculation that finally ended in 1820.

The presence of the Seneca River made travel possible and gave the Village of Baldwinsville its first resident, John McHarrie. The Village is one of the few that is located in two towns, Van Buren and Lysander.

Though the area was heavily forested and bears, wolves and cougars were a menace, the area soon prospered.

More information on the history of the Town of Van Buren is available at the Schacksboro Schoolhouse Museum located on Canton Street.
